

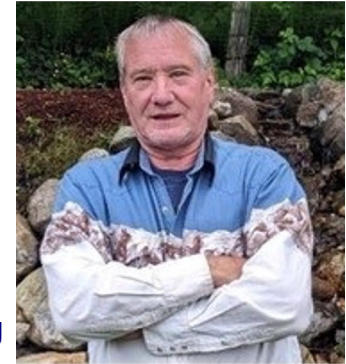

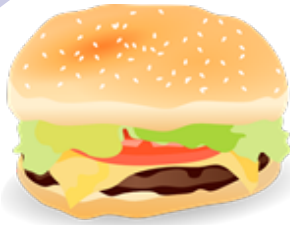

We have a large outdoor Beer Garden, a covered entryway and breezeway. There is RV parking for up to 7 days (*longer requires approval of the Trustees*) in the lower lot with 30 Amp electrical and water (*RV parking is free for Aerie approved events*).
