



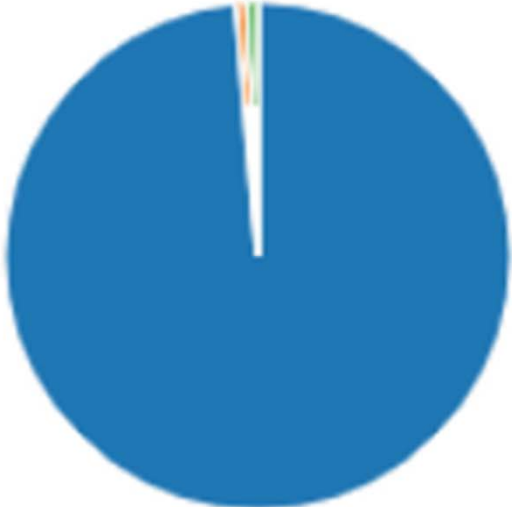

. Our current membership combined is approximately 1,000 members. Do you feel the club is ready to expand its membership with the current facility to facilitate growth?

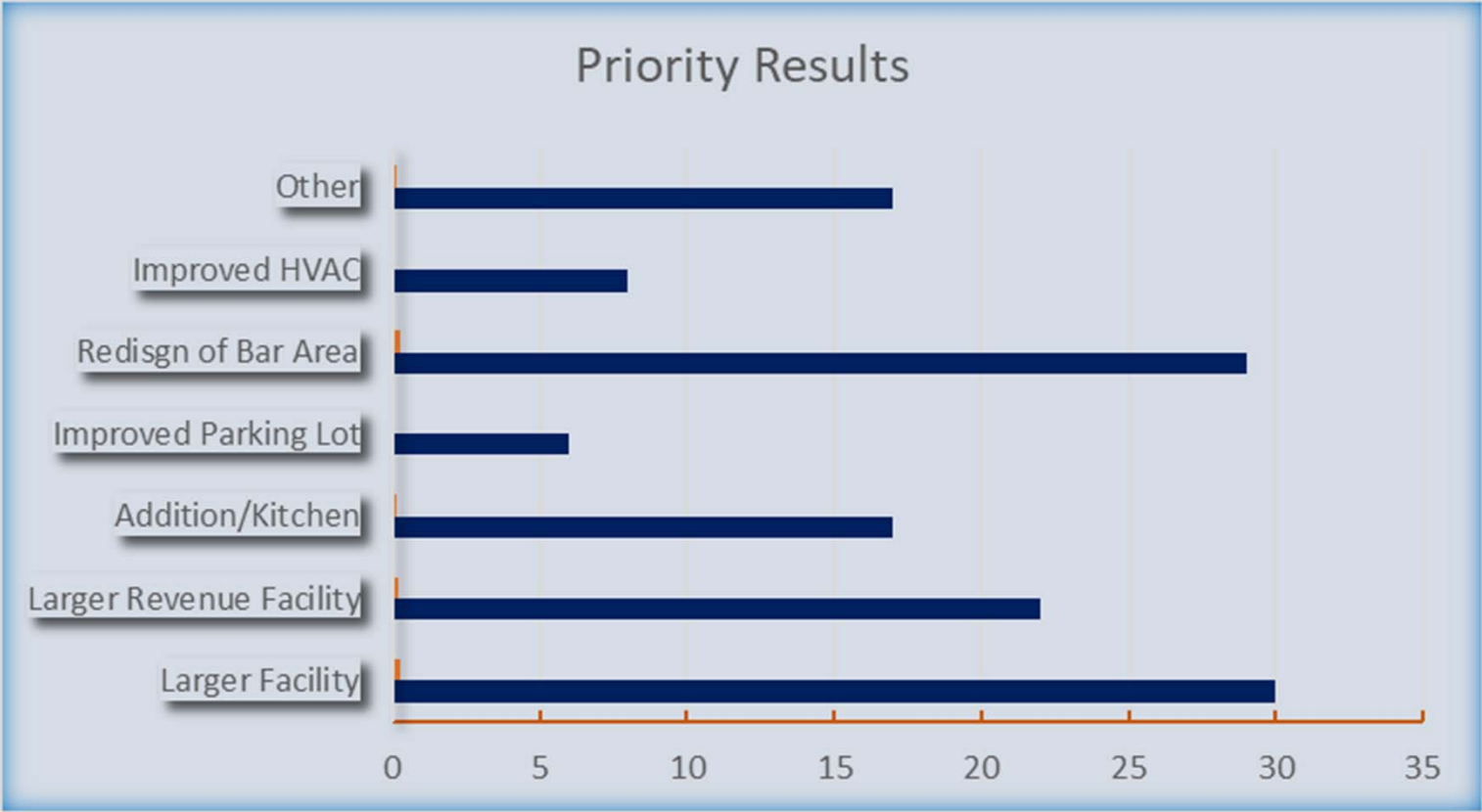


As a member do you think that your voice is heard when decisions are made regarding the overall improvements of the club?

- * Reliable PA system (that doesn't cut out and can be heard throughout the whole club)
- * More bar help on the big event nights (the lines get too long)
- * Get rid of all the jewelry for sale in the club (not sure why it's allowed) and have the new Eagle merchandise and swag samples displayed so members can purchase online)

I would like to see larger restrooms.

We are regular members and already spend quite a lot at the club but if absolutely necessary we would be willing to contribute what we could afford at the time.

It would be nice to design or move things around so the dart players are not interrupted or people don't feel like they are intruding when needing to pass by.

Expanding the club/facilities should be an entirely separate issue based on need and/or "potential" foreseeable growth.
